



Dr. Stan Toler has served as a general superintendent in the Church of the Nazarene as well as a pastor for over 40 years in Ohio, Florida, Tennessee, and Oklahoma. He was elected general superintendent emeritus at the 2013 General Assembly in Indianapolis, Indiana. Most recently, Toler was named Founding Executive Director of the Southern Nazarene University Resource Center for Pastoral Leadership.
